

# PHD THESIS DEFENSE PROCEDURE

## **INSTITUT POLYTECHNIQUE DE PARIS**

The thesis defense is carried out digitally, with all interactions handled via ADUM. Re-enrollment is not required for defenses taking place between September 1 and December 31.

# **Mandatory training**

- **IP PARIS DOCTORAL SCHOOL**: Mandatory proof of at least 100 hours of training before the defense. The course "Ethics of Scientific Research" is compulsory.
- HADAMARD DOCTORAL SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICS (EDMH): Mandatory proof of 120 hours of disciplinary and transversal training (equivalent to 24 credits), distributed as follows:
  - o 60 hours of disciplinary training (12 credits)
  - 60 hours of transversal training (12 credits), including the following 4 compulsory courses:
    - Ethics and scientific integrity
    - Issues of open science
    - Sustainable development
    - Gender-based and sexual violence

A confidential thesis and/or a defense outside IP Paris premises must be declared using the documents available on the IP Paris website: IP Paris - Doctorat



### **DEADLINES AND DEFENSE STEPS**

### 3 months before the defense

- The PhD candidate and thesis supervisor define the defense jury (see "Composition of the jury and reviewers").
- From their personal ADUM account, the candidate enters the jury members and uploads the manuscript (first submission), which may be updated later if necessary.

### 2 months before the defense

- Validation of the jury and reviewers by the different actors via ADUM:
  - Thesis supervisor
  - Field coordinators
  - Doctoral school administrator
  - Doctoral School Director
  - IP Paris Head of Institution
- The thesis supervisor uploads the anti-plagiarism report (Turnitin) in ADUM.
- The library representative validates the thesis submission.
- After approval by the Head of Institution, the doctoral school administrator officially contacts the reviewers and pre-notifies the jury (subject to the manuscript being uploaded in ADUM).

### 1 month before the defense

- Reviewers upload their reports on ADUM.
- The field coordinator and the Doctoral School Director give their opinion on the authorization to defend.
- The IP Paris Head of Institution authorizes the defense.
- The doctoral school administrator sends the official jury summons and grants the candidate access to the defense documents (minutes, defense report).

### Day of the defense

- Oral presentation (45 minutes to 1 hour)
- Questions from the jury
- Jury deliberation



#### **COMPOSITION OF THE JURY AND REVIEWERS**

### IP PARIS DOCTORAL SCHOOL

The jury is composed of:

- At least two reviewers, qualified to supervise research (HDR) or full professors (or equivalent), external to the doctoral project, IP Paris and HEC Paris, and with no joint publications with the candidate or supervisors for at least three years.
- Between 4 and 8 members, including the thesis supervisor, with at least half being professors (or equivalent) and at least half external to the doctoral project, the Doctoral School, IP Paris and HEC Paris.
- It is customary, though **not mandatory**, for reviewers to be part of the jury.

The jury may not include **more than two members** involved in the thesis supervision, or **only one** if the jury has no more than **five members**.

A CSI member **cannot** serve as a reviewer.

Gender balance **must be considered** when composing the jury, in line with the representation of the relevant scientific community.

The jury president, chosen by mutual agreement, **must be a professor or equivalent**. The proposed jury must provide **at least one option** for this role.

**Guests** may be included, though they are **not jury members**.

The composition of the jury is **validated** by the Doctoral School after review by the field coordinator, who may **request changes**.

It appears both on the PhD diploma and on the thesis cover.

### HADAMARD DOCTORAL SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICS (EDMH)

- At least two reviewers, with the possibility of a third if needed (industrial thesis, interdisciplinary work, etc.).
- Reviewers must hold an HDR or equivalent (in accordance with Article 17 of the May 25, 2016
   Decree on Doctoral Training).
- They must be external to EDMH and the enrolling institution (Université Paris Saclay, Institut
  Polytechnique de Paris or Université Paris Sciences et Lettres), except in justified cases for
  disciplinary or thematic reasons.
- If it proves exceptionally difficult to find a competent external reviewer, it is preferable to add an **internal reviewer** in addition to the two official reviewers.

The jury is composed of **4 to 8 members**, and in certain specific cases (industrial theses, cotutelle, interdisciplinary work, etc.), the number may be **limited to 6 members** with the approval of the EDMH steering committee.

- Except in exceptional cases, the jury must include at least one member from the institution responsible for enrollment and defenses, other than the thesis supervisor.
- A CSI member cannot serve as a reviewer.
- It is **strongly recommended** (but not mandatory) that at least one of the reviewers also be a member of the defense jury.
- In accordance with **Article 18 of the Decree of May 25, 2016,** half of the jury must be **external to EDMH and to the institution awarding the degree**.
- The jury must reflect a **balanced representation of women and men**, considering disciplinary realities (example: in 2010, 14% of women were Associate Professors or Professors in section 25, and 27% in section 26).

#### **POST-DEFENSE**

# Within 1 month after the defense (maximum):

- Send the original minutes and defense report to the academic affairs officer.
- Send a digital version by email.

# Within 3 months after the defense (maximum):

- Final deposit of the thesis manuscript in ADUM.
- Validation of the final deposit certificate and authorization for dissemination by the library representative.
- Submission of the diploma production request to the academic affairs officer.
- The academic affairs officer issues the certificate of completion and schedules the diploma edition (maximum processing time: 3 months).
