





#### MASTERS FELLOWSHIPS IN PLASMA PHYSICS

The PLASMAScience Graduate School

The PLASMAScience offers 4 fellowships for highly motivated and talented French and international students enrolling in one of two Masters related to plasma physics at the Institut Polytechnique de Paris - Master 2 of Physics of Plasmas and Fusion and Master 2 Large Facilities (specialties: plasmas) - and the opportunity of an internship in internationally renowned research laboratories to prepare students for tomorrow's challenges.

The Institut Polytechnique de Paris (IP Paris), one of France's leading institutions with a strong reputation in the fundamental science and research, located in Paris area (Palaiseau campus), attracts top students from around the world.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE FELLOWSHIP FUNDING**

- The fellowship package includes:
  - a fellowship of 10K€ for the academic year 2021-2022 for student accepted either in the Master 2 of Physics of Plasmas and Fusion or in the Master 2 Large Facilities (specialties: plasmas) at the Institut Polytechnique de Paris;
  - a research stipend during the 5-month internship at one of 7 host laboratories of the Institut Polytechnique de Paris covering a wide range of topics in plasma physics CMAP, CPHT, LOA, LPICM, LPP, LSI, LULI.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Applicants must hold a Master 1 degree in physics (or equivalent) obtained in France or abroad.
- Candidates independently need to enroll in the Master 2 of Physics of Plasmas and Fusion or in the Master 2 Large Facilities (specialties: plasmas) at the Institut Polytechnique de Paris for the academic year 2021-2022. Candidates, accepted by the pedagogical jury of the Programs, are eligible for the PLASMAScience fellowships.

# **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

The PLASMAScience fellowship program is open for motivated high potential students. The program is selective. Candidates are required to provide the following documents:

- A resume/CV,



- A motivation letter,
- A transcript of completed grades (from current and two previous years),
- Copies of your diploma(s),
- 2 academic references with their contact details,
- A recent colour passport-size photo,
- A copy of your passport or ID card,
- The completed application form.

The application must be submitted before JUNE 20, 2021 to: applications.plasmascience@lpp.polytechnique.fr

The result will be available in July, 2021.
